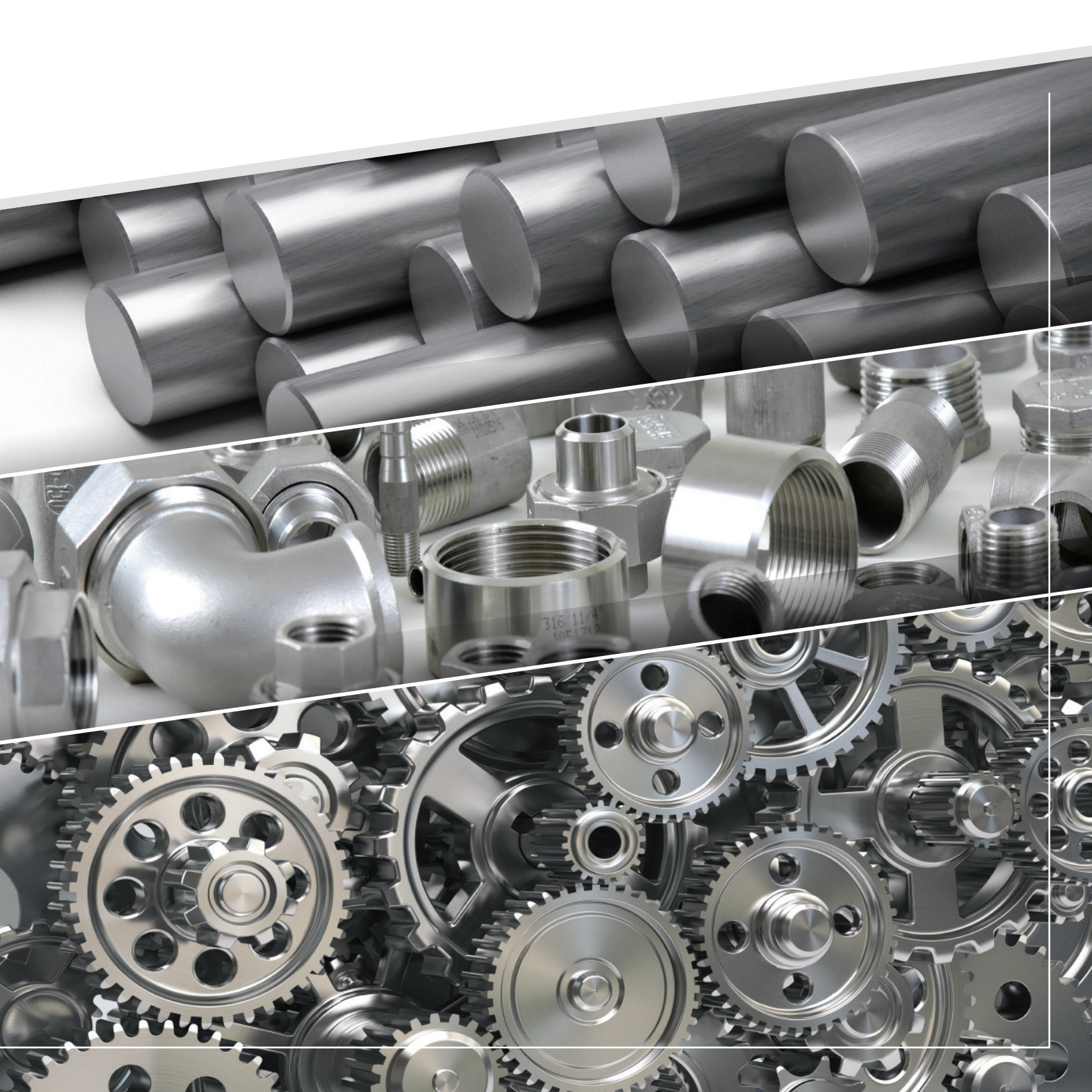

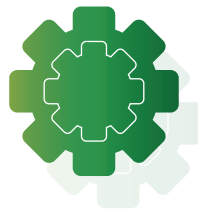

Supply Chain Solutions

Supply chain Solutions have been identified as one of the most crucial tools for the growth and survival of MSMEs in today's intensely competitive market . NSIC facilitates MSMEs by aggregating their demand from across the country.

Input Material Support Scheme (IMSS)

The Input Material Support Scheme (IMSS) of NSIC facilitates MSMEs in procuring essential raw materials and end products at competitive prices through structured MoUs with primary producers and suppliers. By aggregating MSME demand, NSIC secures bulk discounts that are transparently passed on to enterprises, thereby reducing procurement costs and eliminating middlemen. The scheme covers a wide portfolio of end products, including aluminium and PVC doors and windows, solar panels, tiles, sanitary ware, kitchen fittings, PVC panels, and other construction and industrial items, in addition to basic raw materials like steel, aluminium, and cement. Every transaction under IMSS mandates MSME participation, reinforcing inclusivity and credibility. By integrating procurement efficiency with marketing support, IMSS strengthens MSME competitiveness, expands market access, and aligns operations with national priorities on sustainability and equitable growth.





Marketing Support

Marketing has been identified as one of the most crucial tools for the growth and survival of MSMEs in today's intensely competitive market. NSIC acts as a facilitator and has devised a number of schemes to support enterprises in their supply chain and marketing efforts in both domestic and international markets. These schemes are briefly described as under:

Digital Services Facilitation

NSIC operates as an aggregator and facilitator of Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) enabled Digital Services to MSMEs at transparent and affordable prices by way of on-boarding various service providers offering different products/services that are required by MSMEs. For adopting digital ways of managing their businesses, NSIC also offers “MSME Global Mart” as a one-stop, one-window bouquet of utilities which facilitates millions of businesses of any scale existing in India with excellent networking opportunities between buyer and seller across the world. Single Point Registration Scheme

NSIC enlists Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) under Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS) for participation in Government Purchases. The units enlisted under Single Point Registration Scheme of NSIC are eligible to get the benefits under Public Procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order 2012

as notified by the Government of India, Ministry of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises, New Delhi vide Gazette Notification dated 23.03.2012 and amendment vide order no. S.O. 5670(E) dated 9th November 2018. The enlistment under SPRS is completely online. www.nsicsonline.com



Integrated Procurement Support Scheme (IPSS)

The Integrated Procurement Support Scheme (IPSS) establishes a robust procurement framework to ensure efficient material sourcing, liquidity security, and structured financial governance for Master Executing Agency (MEA), such as (A Government Company, Public Sector Unit (PSU), or Large Enterprise operating in Infrastructure, Manufacturing, or Service sectors, etc) overseeing large-scale Infrastructure, Manufacturing, and Service-sector projects awarded by Principal Project Entities (PPE). The scheme enhances MSME participation in large projects through Principal Project Entities (PPE), Master Executing Agency (MEA), backed Bank Guarantees (BGs) to NSIC, thus ensuring timely payment flows to MSMEs. IPSS scheme facilitates MSMEs access to working capital by providing instant payment against material supplies through an integrated procurement and payment mechanism, while ensuring compliance with MSMED Act provisions.



Marketing Facilitation Scheme

The Marketing Facilitation Scheme (MFS) covers only Micro & Small Enterprises registered with NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS). NSIC offers facilitation services to Central Governments, PSUs, and other relevant organizations, State/UT Governments & their Departments, Local bodies, Public/Reputed Private Sector Companies. The scheme does not cover unit(s) engaging in 'trading activities' without value addition/packing/branding. NSIC's role is limited to recommending the LI bidder (lowest bidder) to the buyer (As per DOE Manual), who will then be responsible for awarding the contract.



NSIC Infrastructure Services for MSMEs

To provide impetus to the marketing efforts of MSMEs, NSIC has constructed various infrastructures keeping in view the growing demand for strategically located space to cater to the commercial & marketing needs of MSMEs/IT/ITeS etc. These buildings are located in the prime location and are having excellent connectivity through road, rail and air. - NSIC Business Park' at Sector-V, Saltlake, Kolkata.
- NSIC Software Technology cum Business Park, Chennai.



Exhibition and Technology Fairs

To showcase the competencies of Indian MSMEs, NSIC facilitates participation of MSMEs in International Exhibitions, Fairs, Seminars etc held within the country on concessional terms under the Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme of the M/o MSMEs by partially meeting the cost towards rent of stall etc. Participation in these events exposes MSMEs to wide market reach, international practices and enhances their business prowess. Through participation in these events, MSMEs are facilitated to capture new markets making them globally competitive.



International Cooperation Scheme

The International Cooperation scheme (IC) of the Ministry of MSME aims to build the capacity of MSMEs for entering export market by facilitating their participation in international exhibitions, fairs, conferences, seminars, buyer-seller meets abroad as well as providing them with actionable market, intelligence and reimbursement of various costs involved in export of goods and services. The Scheme provides opportunities to MSMEs to continuously update themselves to meet the challenges emerging out of changes in technology, demand, the emergence of new markets, etc. Thus, in totality, all components of the scheme aim at various aspects required to advance MSMEs position as emerging export player.

➤ The IC Scheme consists of following three sub-components:

- Market Development Assistance (MDA) – (both Physical and Virtual Mode)
- Capacity Building of First Time Exporters (CBFTE)
- Framework for International Market Intelligence Dissemination (IMID)



Credit Support

NSIC facilitates credit requirements of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises in the following areas:

Financing for procurement of Raw Material and Assistance to Wholesalers and Retail Traders Scheme

NSIC facilitates MSMEs in the procurement of raw materials (short term) as per their requirement by entering into arrangements with Bulk Manufacturers. NSIC provides credit support for raw material procurement by making the payment to suppliers under Raw Material Assistance Scheme against the security of Bank Guarantee. Besides under Assistance to Wholesalers and Retail Traders (AWRT) Scheme, NSIC arranges to provide Working Capital requirements for purchase of goods from the wholesalers/manufacturers/retailers which is not prohibited by law or opposed to public interest.

Bill Discounting Scheme

The Scheme covers discounting of bills arising out of genuine trade transactions i.e. supplies made by MSMEs to reputed Public Limited Companies/State and Central Government Departments/Undertakings/Private Limited Companies (not traders), engaged in manufacturing/service activities.

 **NSIC as a Financier on all Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) platform**

TReDS is an RBI-authorized Trade Receivables Discounting System Platform that facilitates the financing and discounting of trade receivables of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) through multiple financiers. The TReDS scheme addresses the critical needs of MSMEs i.e. the twin issues of promptly encashing receivables, eliminating credit risk, factoring without recourse and also helps in appropriate price discovery.

 **Finance through syndication with Banks.**

To meet the credit requirements of MSMEs, NSIC has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with various Nationalized and Private Sector Banks. Through syndication with these banks, NSIC facilitates credit support to MSMEs (fund based or non-fund based limits). Any MSME unit can directly approach the nearest NSIC branch office in their area of operation and submit their request application for loan. NSIC provides complete handholding support without charging any cost to MSMEs.

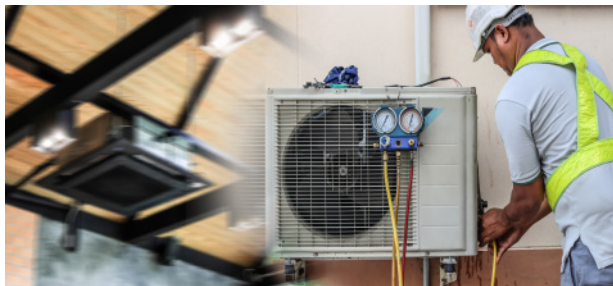
Technology Support

NSIC extends Technical services through NSIC Technical Services Centres (NTSCs), Livelihood Business Incubators (LBIs) and Training Centres (TCs) spread across the country. The core activities of technical services include extending support through skill development, product & material testing, job work facilities to the industries.

Skill Development & Training

Training programs are offered in demand driven, industry oriented high-tech as well as conventional trades.

- High-tech training modules include trades such as CAD/CAM, CNC programming, 3D Printing, Robotics, Automation & Mechatronics, AR-VR, Embedded systems, Solar energy, IT courses etc.
- Conventional trades include Machinist, Welding, Electrician, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Motor Winding and Repair etc.
- Sponsored training programme under Central/State Government schemes.



Testing and Quality Assurance

NABL accredited laboratories provide testing of ferrous and non-ferrous materials, building materials, plastics, wood, soil, bitumen, diesel engines, pumps, electrical conductors, wires & cables, insulators, electrical appliances, calibration services etc.

Job Work for MSMEs

Advanced Tool Rooms equipped with CAD/CAM software and modern machinery such as CNC, VMC, HMC, EDM wire cut, lathes, surface grinding, radial drilling machines, etc. are available to undertake precision job work for industry.

NSIC offers Advanced Integrated Entrepreneurship Development Programme (AIEDP), which combines theoretical knowledge of business management with hands-on training through live and project-based learning.

Models of operations of Incubation Centres

- LBIs operated by NSIC
- Training cum Incubation Centres (TICs) established under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode
- Vocational Training Centre (VTC) / Business Incubation Centre (BIC) established overseas on turnkey basis. NSIC has successfully established such centres in South Africa, Senegal, Ethiopia, Burundi, Rwanda, Zimbabwe, Burkina Faso, Egypt, Gambia and Mozambique.



Enterprise Growth & Graduation Support

NSIC Venture Capital Fund Limited (NVCFL), is a wholly owned subsidiary of NSIC which has been mandated by the Ministry of MSME to create a Fund of Funds, named as Self Reliant India (SRI) Fund, as an Alternate Investment Fund (AIF) with Mother Fund/Daughter Fund structure, registered with SEBI. The Mother Fund has a corpus of Rs.12,000 crore and total Fund corpus is Rs.60,000 crore. SRI Fund shall be providing growth capital to the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises. The setting of SRI Fund would squarely address the challenges faced by MSMEs, give them a thrust to break their barriers, encourage corporatization and allow them to grow to their full inherent potential. With Government intervention, the SRI Fund scheme would be able to channelize diverse variety of funds into underserved MSMEs and address the growth needs of viable and high growth MSMEs.





SRI Fund's Structure

SRI Fund is an investment strategy of holding a portfolio of other investment funds, rather than investing directly. In the context of AIFs, a Fund of Fund is an AIF which invests in another AIF. Accordingly, SRI Fund is a combination of Mother Fund which will leverage private equity/other funds and thus will multiply the impact of the initial budgetary infusion. Mother Fund will provide funds only to the Daughter Funds for onward investment as growth capital, while the investment in MSMEs will be done by the Daughter Funds. Both the Mother and Daughter Funds have to be duly registered as Alternate Investment Funds with SEBI. With a view to providing flexibility to the Daughter funds in providing both equity and debt funding to the MSMEs, the Daughter funds are either Category I or II AIFs registered with SEBI.



SRI Fund's benefits

- Enhancing equity/equity like financing to MSMEs on Stock Exchange.
- Supporting faster growth of MSME Businesses and thereby ignite the economy and create employment opportunities;
- Supporting enterprises which have the potential to graduate beyond the MSME bracket to become National/International Champions;
- Supporting MSMEs which help making India self-reliant by producing relevant technologies, goods and services.
- Accepting exports and value creation of the units.
- Promoting local manufacturing.
